

## From l'Esquirol to Sant Pere de Torelló

The sixth stage of the principal route now connects two very different counties, though they still have close ties. In one canton we discover the wealth of the sunny side, full of forests of oaks and Holm oaks, and on the other side, sheltered in the shade, there is the vegetation more typical of a river bank. We will go crossing over rivers and little streams until we arrive in Sant Pere de Torelló, the capital of the lathe manufacturing county. In times past there were artisans, while nowadays the work is more industrialized.

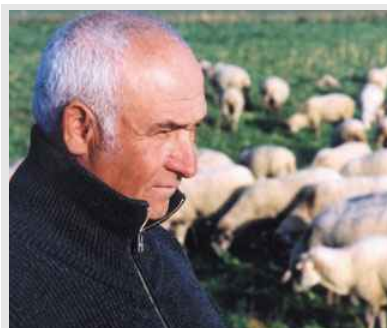
